School Uniform

September 2022

Our policy for children's school uniform is based on the belief that a school uniform: promotes a sense of pride in the school; encourages a feeling of community and belonging; is practical and smart; identifies the children with the school; is not distracting in class; and makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance.

The school uniform consists of:

- White shirt with school tie (all children wearing a shirt should wear a tie)
Or a white polo shirt
- Grey trousers, grey shorts, grey pinafore dress or grey skirt
- Royal blue sweatshirt with school logo (crew neck, v-neck or cardigan)

Summer

- Cotton dress (blue & white check or stripe)

Shoes

- These need to be sensible black 'school shoes' without a 'high' heel. Boots (especially up to the knee) are inappropriate and can lead to accidents whilst the children are running around at playtime.

We also request that jewellery is restricted to a watch and stud earrings and no bracelets, necklaces, nail polish or transfer tattoos are worn.

P.E.

- Black or navy shorts, leggings or joggers
- White tee-shirt (rounded neck)
- Trainers
- Royal blue or red fleece

ALL CLOTHES SHOULD BE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THE CHILD'S NAME.
