



Dear parents/carers,

As you will be aware, should an individual within a year group bubble receive a positive test result, we will be required to close the bubble for self-isolation and provide immediate remote education. As a school, we have been making provisions for this, which we would like to share with you.

In school, pupils are now familiar with the online platform 'Seesaw', which can be accessed via the app on mobile or tablet devices, or via the website on desktop devices.

Your child may have already been set homework via Seesaw, in which case you will have received their individual QR code (for access on mobile or tablet devices) and 16-character text code (for use on desktop devices). If your child has not yet been asked to access Seesaw at home, these codes are now attached to this letter.

By logging into their individual area, your child will be able to view work set and respond, and also share any activities they have been completing at home by adding pictures, videos, text or documents to their 'journal'. This can then be viewed by staff, who can provide personalised feedback.

In the event of a bubble closure, you will receive further information about accessing this platform and work set. In the meantime, please take a look at the website or download the app, and encourage your child to talk to you about how they have been using the platform in school. We have been very impressed so far at the expertise pupils have been developing when making use of Seesaw in class!
