Week 2 (Summer 1) – Travelling on water

This week we plan to...

- Continue our new topic '**Under the Sea**'.
- Discuss ways of travelling on water and read '**Brilliant Boats**'. Introduce new vocabulary specific to boats e.g., mast, sail.
- Use recyclable resources to make a boat. Does this float or sink? Why?
- Explore pushing boats down the guttering. Which boat is the fastest? What could we do to make the boat move faster? Would we need more water?
- Explore floating and sinking in the water tray. Why do some objects float and some sink? Use vocabulary heavy and light.
- Learn all about the concept between. Look at our coat peg and notice that it is between two coat pegs. Whose peg is between? Discuss who is sat between us during carpet time.
- Learn about 3D shapes e.g., sphere, cube, cuboid. How do they differ to 2D shapes?
- To make sailor hats and role-play going to sea. What might we see? Hear? Smell?
- Continue with our Phonics lessons!
