## This week we plan to...

- Start our new topic of 'Let's go wild!'
- Read 'The Gruffalo' and 'A Walk in the Woods' and talk about the animals in the story. Share our experiences of the woods and any animals that we have seen there.
- Sort animals into wild and not wild and discuss what this means. Do we have wild animals as pets?
- Explore animal footprints and try to make these in playdough.
- Talk about our role in caring for animals and the local environment.
- To make a Gruffalo Crumble.
- Learn all about the concept 'back'. When lining up talk about who is at the back.
- Identify the initial sounds in woodland animals e.g. d-d-deer, b-b-badger and see if we can record these using our RWI handwriting phrases.
- Talk about length, sorting objects that are long and short.
  Explore measuring using cubes, footprints and rulers.
