

This week we plan to...

- Start our new topic of '**Let's go wild!**'
- Read '**The Gruffalo**' and '**A Walk in the Woods**' and talk about the animals in the story. Share our experiences of the woods and any animals that we have seen there.
- Sort animals into wild and not wild and discuss what this means. Do we have wild animals as pets?
- Explore animal footprints and try to make these in playdough.
- Talk about our role in caring for animals and the local environment.
- To make a Gruffalo Crumble.
- Learn all about the concept '**back**'. When lining up talk about who is at the **back**.
- Identify the initial sounds in woodland animals e.g. d-d-deer, b-b-badger and see if we can record these using our RWI handwriting phrases.
- Talk about length, sorting objects that are long and short. Explore measuring using cubes, footprints and rulers.
