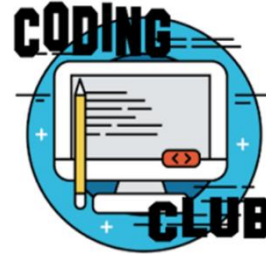
Sporting Success
