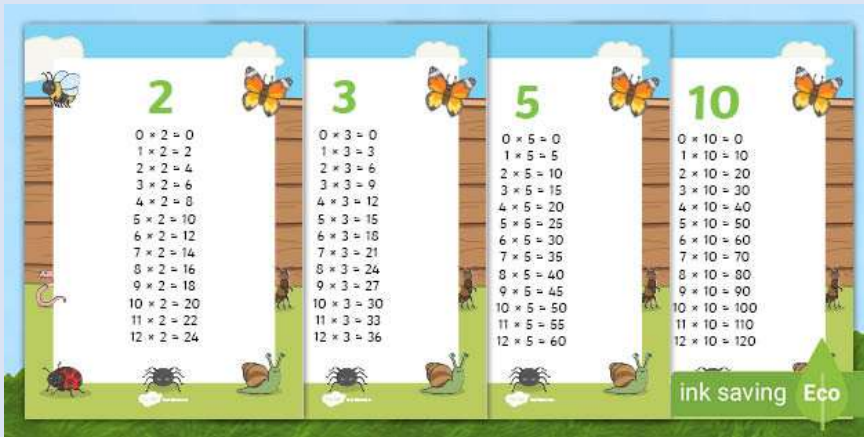


Key Instant Recall Facts

Count in 2s, 5s, 10s (and 3s).

Support

- Start with 10 then 5, then 2 to build understanding and develop links.
- Work practically – put items into groups or draw dots and group together.
- Look for patterns to help with recall – EG – when counting in 10s, each number ends with a 0.

Challenge

- Recall the facts with increasing speed.
- Count in 3s when secure with 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s beyond the times table. EG in 10s up to 100.
- Pose the question in a different way. How many 5s make 50?
