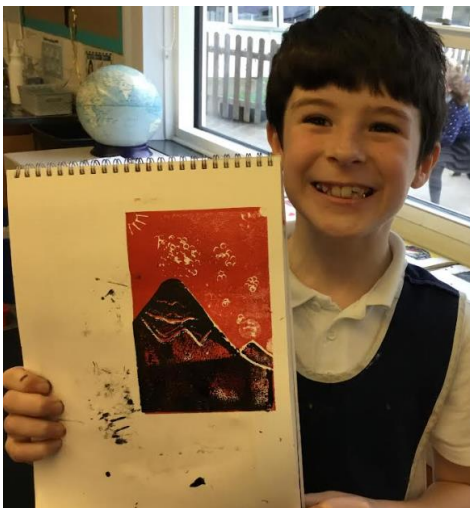


Our focus on reading both for pleasure and for purpose is continuing across school and year 5 have been relaxing with some great texts!
