Years 1-3 Class Winners – Year 1 – Mrs Waters with 97.5%

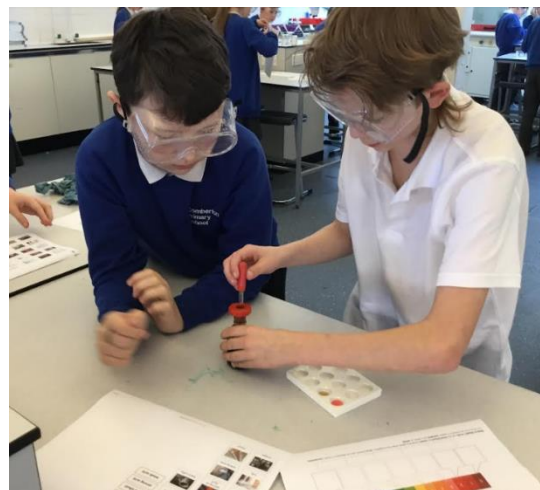
Years 4-6 Class Winners – Year 5 – Mrs Illyas with 98.8%
