- Choose the right words and actions for the situation
- Take pride in our school environment
- Right place at the right time
- Show empathy

Unexpected behaviours

- Ignoring adult instructions
- Talking over others
- Disrupting learning for others
- Being off-task
- Disrespectful words or tone
- Physical retaliation
- Damaging our school or things in it
- Choosing to be in the wrong place
