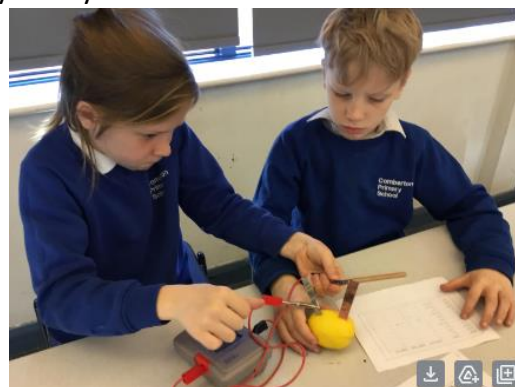
Learning
