Year 1 had a fantastic time on their trip to Aston Hall today – they were full of enthusiasm on their return. The children loved dressing up and considering what life was like in historical times, making comparisons to today. They were blessed with sunshine meaning they could also make the most of the outdoors and beautiful grounds.



We had visitors from Severn Trent in this week to lead assemblies and workshops for the children to teach them all about water! They learnt about the water cycle, how water is cleaned, the impact of pollution and how water keeps our bodies healthy.
