Well done to all children in year 1, some year 2's and year 4 who have taken their statutory assessments this week – phonics for years 1 and 2 and multiplication times table check for year 4. We are really proud of how much progress the children have made and how hard they have all worked. Results cannot be shared until we have these officially but they will be included as part of their end of year school report.

Year 4 have been working hard on their writing of 'The Promise' and Year 6 'Paradise Garden.' Do ask your children about this as I have seen some great creativity and excellent language choices.

Year 4 have also been practising hard in preparation for their cornet performance to parents which is being held on 10th July. We hope lots of you will be able to make this.

Year 2 enjoyed a fabulous trip to Bishop's Wood where they were building on their knowledge of animals and their habitats. The staff at Bishop's Wood were so complimentary about the level of understanding that our children already brought and how well they could talk about their learning. We still have a few places left in Nursery and Reception for September 2024. If you know of anyone who is still considering their options, then please do encourage them to contact the school for a tour.



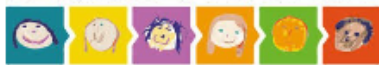
Bookings for summer HAF will open on Tuesday 11th June.

Who can take part in Worcestershire summer HAF activities?

- Children aged 5-16 who receive benefits-related Free School Meals (FSM)
- There is some limited availability of places for non-FSM children deemed vulnerable, however please note, **in line with government guidelines these places are not guaranteed** and are given at the activity providers discretion. These children include:
 - Children assessed by the local authority as being in need, at risk or vulnerable
 - Young carers
 - Children with an EHCP (education, health and care) plan
 - Children of refugee families
 - Looked after children who are in Kinship Care
 - Children living in areas of high deprivation or from low-income households who are not in receipt of free school meals
 - Children in transition phases between nursery and primary school or primary and secondary school

You must be approved as eligible for HAF on our website in order to book HAF places on 11th June. [Log in here](#). If you did not register on the new website at Easter, you will need to register and be approved on the new website. Please make sure to add all of your children before
