Summer Fayre

We are still on the hunt for items for our bric a-brac, teddy tombola and cake stall. Any donations will be welcomed next week.

Collection will be as it was for the Easter Fayre, where you will be asked to sign your child out from their classroom at 1:55pm. You will then be responsible for your child from this point. If you have made arrangements for your child to go around the fayre with another family, then please ensure your child's class teacher is aware of this so that they know who they are signing them out to.

If you are unable to take your child around the fayre but wish to send them with some money to spend, then we will do our very best to find a school adult to take them around.

Any child not attending the summer fayre will be supervised in a classroom with school adults. Nursery, reception, years 1 and 2 will be in Reception. Children from years 3-6 will go to the year 4 mobile. Any child not collected by 1:55pm will be sent to one of these spaces so that the school staff can get to their stalls. Should you wish to collect your child at any point after 1:55pm, you will need to collect them from these spaces.

Years 5 and 6 will receive a separate letter for you to give permission for them to attend the summer fayre unaccompanied should you wish.

As always, we ask that you bring as much loose change as you can to the summer fayre as we have very limited floats!

Art Galleries

We do hope that lots of you will join your child to see their artwork in our first ever Art Galleries next week. The children are really excited to show off what they have created. In the same way as the summer fayre, please go to your child's classroom door to sign them out at 2:40pm on your allocated day, where you can then take them around the art gallery. You will be responsible for them from this point. Again, please let your child's class teacher know if you have arranged for them to be signed out by someone else.

There will be a donations bucket to go towards art supplies and refreshments so please bring some loose change and give generously if you can.

Library and Reading Books

Please ensure all library books and reading books are returned and handed in next week so that we can reorganise these over the summer.

Lockers for Years 4, 5 and 6

Next year in the new building, children in years 4, 5 and 6 will have small lockers, instead of pegs – which they are very excited about! The locker dimensions are 30cm x 30cm x 30cm (standard primary school size). These will need to fit their coats, bags and lunch boxes inside. Reading books and water bottles will be taken into class. Therefore it is essential that the children only have a small drawstring bag as otherwise they will not fit their belongings in their lockers and there will not be any alternative space for big bags to be stored. We are so proud of all of year 6 pupils who did a fantastic job in their SATs. The results were released this week and each individual child really did surpass themselves. We are also exceptionally proud that as a school, we continue to achieve outcomes significantly above the National outcomes in most areas.
