Reading Books

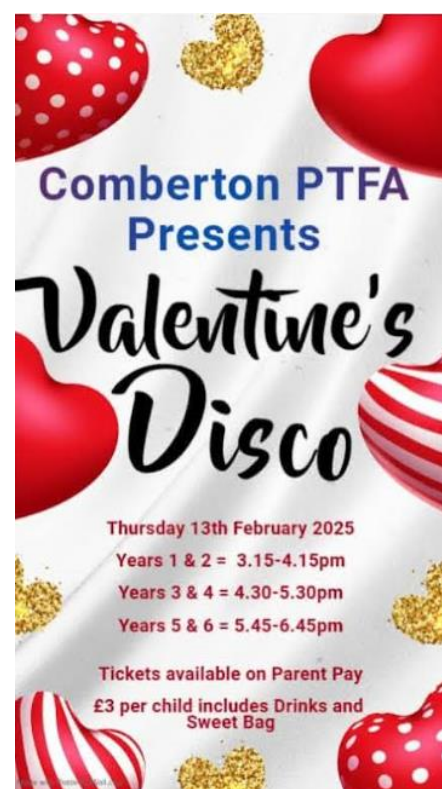
