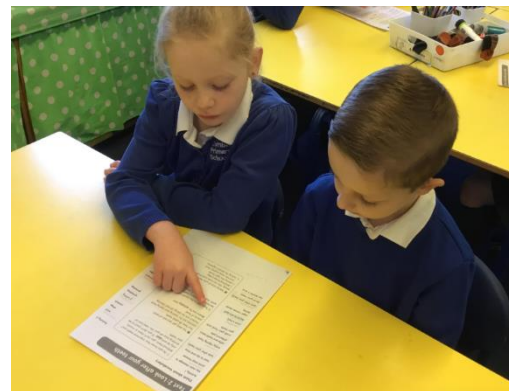

We are so proud of our children who access their daily phonics and reading groups across key stage 1. They understand the routines and expectations and remain focused and engaged which is resulting in excellent progress.
