Whole School Attendance: 94.9%

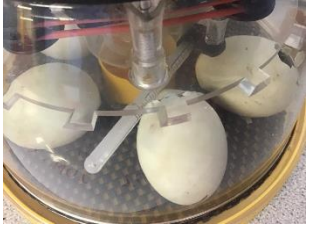
Years 1-3 Class Winners – Year 2 – Mrs Heath with 99.4%

Learning

Learning has quite literally come to life in front of the eyes of our Reception children this week. We have ducklings who have come to stay with us for 2 weeks! The children have watched them hatch from their eggs into baby chicks that they will nurture and care for as they grow over the next week. They have been handling them with care and next week, will bath and play with them. This is supporting the children's understanding of life cycles and living things.



In science, year 2 have been sorting seeds and bulbs so have used the microscopes to get a closer look. It created such a sense of awe and wonder in the room that the children were then able to follow their own lines of enquiry. Some of the children peeled off the outer layers of the bulb to look at and others moved on to observing the skin on their hands. The children showed great collaboration throughout this experience.
