It's been a really busy week in school, especially for our year 6 pupils who have had their SATs assessments. We couldn't be prouder of the resilience they showed and effort they put in every day. School receive results in July and we will share the outcomes at this point.

Reception have been learning about different countries over this half term and this week has focussed on India. The children have been exploring Indian culture and looking at colours and pattern in their own art work.

Year 3 have been learning about animation in art and have really enjoyed beginning their very own drawn animations. Year 4 have been writing suspense stories and the adults have been really impressed with the vocabulary they have chosen to create pictures in the reader's mind and build tension throughout.

Year 3 and 6 had a really special computing experience today, with a visiting VR workshop. Linked to their history topics, children in year 6 got to experience the war first hand and year 3, the Ancient Greeks through a fully immersive VR experience.
