It's been a busy week in school with the statutory assessments and trips on top of the usual curriculum learning! Children in Reception have been continuing their learning about the world and this week focussed on Antarctica. They showed some amazing problem solving skills when working together to try and build a giant igloo out of sugar cubes!

Year 2 had a wonderful trip to Bishop's Wood where they explored microhabitats, created natural art and enjoyed discovering the wildlife during pond dipping. This complimented their science learning for the term and the children showed excellent scientific knowledge.



Year 4 enjoyed a fantastic trip to Harvington Hall as part of their learning about Tudor Times. They looked around the Elizabethan home, learnt about dining etiquette in a visit to the kitchen, explored the Priest holes, rehearsed Tudor dancing and had a go at the Tudor past time of archery! We were exceptionally proud to receive a special phone call the following day to praise our children for their impeccable behaviour and enthusiasm for learning.



Year 6 have continued to work incredibly hard on their writing for their final assessment pieces. They have been retelling the story of 'Paradise garden', including dialogue to convey the characters and advance the action. What a super job they have done!

## Year 1 Phonics and Year 4 Multiplication Check
