Learning

Nursery and Reception children had a wonderful experience with visitor Steve, the animal man, from Dinosaur and Wildlife Education Centre. The children (and staff!) were so brave in holding and interacting with many different animals and reptiles and learnt loads of interesting facts along the way. The children have taken this back into their classroom learning and have been immersed in everything dinosaurs!

Bags for September 2025
