Art Gallery

We have now confirmed year groups and timings for our Art Gallery on Mon 14th and Tues 15th July.

School Meals

You will be receiving a letter from our catering company 'Innovate' to inform you of an increase in meal price from September. This is in line with their cost of food and services. The new meal price will be £2.85.

Bags for September 2025

Just a reminder that all pupils moving into years 4, 5 and 6 in September will need to have small draw string bags only (no rucksacks). The children are allocated lockers in phase 2 and these are very small by design. There is just enough room for their coat, lunchbox (if needed) and a small drawstring bag where the ties can be tucked in. Water bottles are taken into the classroom and stored there for easy access throughout the day. Thank you in advance for your support and co-operation with this.

Fruit/Snacks for September 2025

A reminder that all children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are entitled to the free fruit in school provided under the Government scheme. Once children reach year 3 and above, this is no longer available and therefore, should you wish your child to have a snack at playtime, this will need to be provided from home. Please ensure snacks remain healthy such as fruit or cereal bars.

Uniform Donations

We are really low on any spare uniform for our older pupils. If your child is leaving at the end of year 6 and you have any uniform that you would be able to donate, then we would be most grateful.

We are already having lots of enquiries for places for September 2026 and have shown some families around Comberton as they begin to consider their options.
